Solidarity: love of neighbor




The Nativity of Our Lord

Charity & the dignity of all human life




The Presentation




Baptism of Jesus:




Agony in the Garden

Perseverance




The Crucifixion




The Resurrection

The Creed

Salve Regina



- 2 – Our Father
- 3 – 3 Hail Marys: 1 each for faith, hope & charity
- 4 – *Glory be to the Father...*
- 5 – Announce 1st mystery, Our Father
- 6 – Contemplate 1st mystery while praying 10 Hail Marys
- 7 – *Glory be..., Oh My Jesus*, announce 2nd mystery, Our Father
- 8 – Contemplate 2nd mystery while praying 10 Hail Marys
- 9 – *Glory be..., Oh My Jesus*, announce 3rd mystery, Our Father
- 10 – Contemplate 3rd mystery while praying 10 Hail Marys
- 11 – *Glory be..., Oh My Jesus*, announce 4th mystery, Our Father
- 12 – Contemplate 4th mystery while praying 10 Hail Marys
- 13 – *Glory be..., Oh My Jesus*, announce 5th mystery, Our Father
- 14 – Contemplate 5th mystery while praying 10 Hail Marys
- 15 – Salve Regina, closing prayer & Sign of the Cross
