Amen.


The Resurrection

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy.




The Ascension

***O my Jesus,** forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy.*




Descent of the Holy Spirit

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were.

Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. *(Acts 2)*

The Assumption

When Jesus had said this, he raised his eyes to heaven and said, “Father, the hour has come. Give glory to your son, so that your son may glorify you... Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the one whom you sent...

Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world.... I pray not only for them, but for all those who believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they may also be us.

(John 17)

[A]fter we have poured forth prayers of supplication again and again to God, and have invoked the light of the Spirit of Truth, for the glory of Almighty God... by the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, and by our own authority, we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: That the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory.

(Pius XII, *Munificentissimus Deus*)

Mother of God, pray with us that we, like you, by believing and bringing your Son’s Word to others, may be joined with you and with them in the Father, together with your Son Jesus Christ and all who believe, in the unity of the Holy Spirit.
