The Baptism of Christ

[John] saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world... the reason why I came baptizing with water was that he might be made known to Israel... I saw the Spirit come down like a dove from the sky and remain upon him. I did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'On whomever you see the Spirit come down and remain, he is the one who will baptize with the holy Spirit.' Now I have seen and testified that he is the Son of God." (John 1)

Lord, we pray that by recalling constantly the continuing grace of our baptism we may remain washed clean of sin; and that through the purifying grace of the fire you have placed in us, we may be prompted to bring to the world the light and truth of the good news of dignity and love that you were sent to bring to us, particularly by participating in society in accordance with our abilities and your Word.



The Wedding Feast at Cana

On the third day there was a wedding in Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, ... His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you..."

And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, [he] called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." (John 2)

Mother of God, it was at your gentle command that Christ shared the first of his public works, when you sought to ensure that others might have the means to celebrate in joy. We pray that, like Jesus, we may be quick to obey, and that in doing so we may enable others to celebrate with your Son in the light of truth and good works.




Proclamation of the Kingdom

When he saw the crowds, he went up the mountain, and after he had sat down, his disciples came to him.

Mother of God, we pray that by setting aside all things of this life and listening attentively at the feet of your Son, his teachings may be infused into our very being, so that he will send us forth to bring his light to the world, and by participating in society help lead it to the gate where your Son waits.

We did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we had been eyewitnesses of his majesty. For he received honor and glory from God the Father when that unique declaration came to him from the majestic glory, "This is my Son, my beloved, with whom I am well pleased."

We ourselves heard this voice come from heaven while we were with him on the holy mountain.

Moreover, we possess the prophetic message that is altogether reliable. You will do well to be attentive to it, as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts. (2 Peter 1)

Mother of God, we pray that by absorbing the reliable prophetic message brought to us by your Son, we may be well formed to carry that message forth to the world, so that good and holy leaders may be identified and bring the dawn and the morning star to the hearts of all; that we might all find our way to you together, in unity with the Father the Son and the Holy Spirit.



Institution of the Holy Eucharist

When the hour came, he took his place at table with the apostles. He said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer, for, I tell you, I shall not eat it [again] until there is fulfillment in the kingdom of God..."

Then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you. *(Luke 22)*

Mother of God, we pray that by forming ourselves properly to carry the light of Christ to the world, we may participate in the selection of just and worthy leaders, who will enable all souls to seek and find the truth which is God the Father.

Humbly we pray that, partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit.
