Q. 1. What draws you to the vocation of service as a Catholic school trustee?

Q. 2. What do you hope to accomplish as a Catholic school trustee?

I hope to use my voice on behalf of the parents and staff of Dufferin/Caledon and I want to ensure that the parents have the roll as first educators as they are the greatest advocate for their children.

Q. 3. What experience do you have that qualifies you to serve as a Catholic school trustee?

Business Skills:

I am self-employed. I own and operate my own jewellery design business selling online with Amazon. For 19 years my family and I have owned and operated the Sandhill Shell Gas Station, where I acted as manager and bookkeeper.

Christianity Background:

I am a dedicated Catholic, for years I have participated as Eucharistic minister and I actively study the Bible. I also participate online nightly with other local Catholics to pray the Rosary.

Service History:

I have volunteered at the schools, our church and I also actively raise funds for our local women's shelter.

Q.4. In your view, what are the most important contributions Catholic education can make to the lives of children, and the communities they will become part of?

It is so important to teach our children about our faith, and how it relates to our heritage and history. I think it is most important to teach our children traditional Biblical values of love God and love one another, teaching acceptance, respect and honour. We were all made in the image of God and we have gathered together to celebrate him.

Q.7. In addition to ensuring that students are taught the Catholic notion of incorporating faith into all aspects of our lives, trustees are responsible for ensuring that students are encouraged to do their very best in all their studies, covering the full range of provincial educational curricula. How do you see yourself assisting in that process?

It is important to provide quality resources to all students so that they are properly supported and encouraged to succeed.

Q.8. In order to ensure that Catholic schools and the communities they teach in remain true to the Catholic faith, it is important that Catholic school boards and individual trustees remain in contact with their local parishes and bishops. What is your plan for remaining in touch?

I hope to have a cordial open dialogue with all local parishes as well as all levels of the Archdiocese. I will continue to be very active with the parishes within my district.

Q.9. Some have proposed that separate Catholic schools be abolished. In what ways do you envision yourself advocating for the continuing rights of Catholics to educate their children in separate Catholic public schools?

I am a strong supporter of separate Catholic schools and I am not alone. I would advocate that the separate Catholic schools continue to be funded publicly and I would ensure the voices of the Catholic supporters are heard.

Q.10. Trustees are responsible to students and parents for ensuring that the fullness of Catholic values, beliefs and teachings are passed on to our children, and for helping to ensure that our children carry those values and teachings into the broader community. How do you propose to ensure that you yourself are aware of the full range of matter you will be expected to impart to students?

I take this responsibility very seriously. It is very important to me that I try to impart genuine Catholic values, beliefs and teachings in my own day to day life. I continue to try to understand the teachings of God myself and demonstrate His Grace in my life the best that I can although I often fall short. I will strongly advocate for these beliefs and teachings to be referenced in the daily schedules.

Q.11. As elected public officials, trustees are accountable to their constituents for prudent, wise, and equitable use of resources, in an open and accountable fashion. In what specific ways do you propose to discharge that duty?

I will work to increase transparencies by asking the necessary questions and requesting full disclosure so that I can share these important facts to the constituents. Parents should have a clear understanding of what the board is spending its budget on.
